Psalm 68 was written on the occasion when the Ark of the LORD was returning from the house of Obed-Edom to the city of David (full account in 2 Samuel 6) and the author was leading a procession of musicians and priests in worshipping, singing and dancing along through the crowd who were there to welcome the Ark - a symbol of the Presence of the LORD. It was a jubilant and reverent sight reminding the people that the LORD is the God of Israel, the all-powerful, the one true living God.

Verse 28 says *“Summon your power, God; show us your strength, our God, as you have done before.”* King David was acknowledging that all their victories were won by the power communicated from above, henceforth, he had the confidence that the LORD would continue to help them in the future regardless of the challenging and demanding situation. **GOD IS FAITHFUL.** In this pandemic situation that we are facing today, let us call upon the LORD our loving Father to demonstrate His power and strength once more to stop the transmission and to help us to go through this environment of fear and uncertainty.
